

IGI Cheat Sheet

To maintain your status as a chapter in good standing with the IFC: The bylaws state that houses must: “meet and maintain at least Satisfactory standing as outlined in the Illinois Greek Initiative.”

What are those standards for performance?

Exceptional Performance

Each chapter falling within this category has demonstrated exceptional performance across all sections and is noted as being a top chapter on the university. All chapters that meet these standards have scored 85% or above as their total score.

Satisfactory Performance

Each chapter falling within this category has demonstrated that their chapter has maintained good standing within the IFC. All chapters that meet these standards have scored between 60-84.99% as their total score.

Unsatisfactory Performance

Each chapter falling within this category has demonstrated poor performance and has not maintained good standing within the IFC. All chapters that meet these standards have scored below 60% as their total score.

Chapters that are under probationary status as imposed by their respective national affiliation will be automatically considered Unsatisfactory until IFC is notified that said status has been changed.

Why this matters:

WE WILL REDUCE YOUR DUES

- (i) No deductions shall be given for Chapters below the Satisfactory status of 60%;
- (ii) Any Chapter receiving Exceptional status, 85%, shall receive 50% off their dues;
- (iii) Any Chapter with an IGI status between 60% and 85% completion shall receive a reduction in dues within the range of 10% to 50%. The percent in reduction should be linearly proportional to their percentage of completion between Satisfactory and Exceptional status.
 - How this is calculated:

- $[(\% \text{ completed} - 60 \text{ (bare minimum)}) / (85 \text{ (exceptional)} - 60\% \text{ (min)})] * (50 - 10) + 10\% = \text{Percent reduced}$

EXTRA INCENTIVES FOR RECRUITMENT

If you are in the exceptional range: “Recognition will include exposure on the Interfraternity Council website, mention in the Greek inserts in the University-provided information given to incoming freshman, letters of commemoration to national affiliation, a press release for the chapter to use in their alumni newsletter or any other pertinent publication, a large banner displaying the chapter’s accomplishments, an advertisement in the Daily Illini funded by IFC (in the spring semester following the chapter’s naming as exceptional), and an award received at the Greek Oscars ceremony.”
