There are 10 different periods available during which Registered Student Organizations can submit applications to the SORF board for review.

Things the SORF Board considers when administering funding:

- Event is free for all UIUC students and open to all members of the UIUC community
- Event/activity is fundamental to the success of the organization as it relates to the mission of the organization
- Level of accessibility of the event to University students
- The range of experiences the program can provide
- Program expenses compared to the number of students served or impacted by event/activity
- If similar activities are offered free through University departments or programs
- Whether requested equipment is available for free or rent by other sources at a reasonable cost (departments, RSO Office, or OFAB)
- Whether the organization has sought out co-sponsorships and/or collaborative efforts with other groups or organizations
- Organization is contributing significant financial resources and not relying solely on SORF funding
- Organization must be in compliance with the [Student Code](#), especially Section 2-507 for Contractual Service requests
